Copies of the race rules are available on request. All entries to this event must have the first 5 flights fully molted. Paterson Club reserves the right to test birds for the illegal use of drugs or stimulants. Benzing & Bricon electronic systems are allowed as well as mechanical timers. Entrant must be aware, agree, and be willing to comply with the Paterson Race drug enforcement policy; non compliance will be grounds for disqualification and forfeiture of any credits due. Participation in Paterson sponsored races is a privilege extended by invitation only.
